Weekly Media Summary & "BLOTTER" Review

District 1 – Lt. Jim Fleming (North County)

On November 5, Sgt. E. Ward was sent to a residence on Crockett Martin Road in reference to a family violence call. On arrival the Deputy observed a male at the rear of the residence. As the Deputy approached the male started running into a wooded area and was apprehended a short distance later. The 49 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 9:18pm and transported to jail.

A 29 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 5:02am, November 6, and taken to jail from a location near Firewood and Oak Forest Drive by Sgt. E. Ward for a criminal mischief warrant out of Waco PD. The Deputy was investigating a suspicious male call.

Deputy S. Ortiz arrested a 43 year old male from Willis at 10:13am, November 6, on FM 1484 near Holly Lane for two outstanding capias warrants. Another male, 67 years old, was also arrested for a theft by check warrant out of Montgomery County. Both were taken to jail. The Deputy had stopped the males on a traffic violation.

A 25 year old female from Willis was arrested at 3:50pm, November 6, and taken to jail from a residence on Honey Hill by Deputy C. Sullivent for a surety to surrender warrant (accident involving damage to a vehicle) out of Montgomery County. The Deputy was on a disturbance.

A 46 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 12:25am, November 7, and taken to jail from a residence on Wilson Road by Sgt. E. Ward for a set aside bond warrant (indecent with a child) out of Montgomery County. The Deputy was on a warrant service.

A 46 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 5:22am, November 7, and taken to jail from a residence on Metts Road by Deputy J. Bourne for a parole violation (blue warrant) out of TDCJ. The Deputy received information on the location of the male.

On November 7, Deputy S. Degner responded to a residence on Hwy 75N in reference to a family violence assault. The Deputy met with a female who advised she and her brother got into an argument and the male struck her on top of the head with a close pocket knife. The male had a previous conviction for family violence assault. The 34 year old male was arrested at 10:43pm and transported to jail charged with a felony.

A 34 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 12:56am, November 8, and taken to jail from a residence on Bert Brown Road by Deputy Z. Winford for a possession of a controlled substance warrant out of Montgomery County and a fail to appear warrant out of JP 4 Montgomery County. The Deputy was on a warrant service.

A 39 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 2:40am, November 8, and taken to jail from a residence on Wagers Street by Deputy S. Degner for a fraudulent use of identifying information warrant out of Montgomery County. The Deputy was on a warrant service.

A 28 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 1:05pm, November 8, and taken to jail from a residence on Adcock Acres by Deputy A. Terrell for a forgery warrant out of Montgomery County. The Deputy was on a warrant service.

Deputy C. Santoro conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in an area near Browder Traylor and Plaster Circle at 11:32pm, November 8. The 32 year old male driver from Conroe was wanted for two capias pro fine warrants and two traffic warrants and the 34 year old female passenger, from Livingston, was also wanted for two traffic warrants. All warrants were out of Montgomery County. Both subjects were transported to jail.

A 50 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 7:33pm, November 9, and taken to jail from a residence on Tommy Smith Road by Deputy S. Squier for six warrants out of Montgomery County JP 4. The Deputy was on an investigation.

A 35 year old male from Conroe was arrested at 8:02pm, November 10, and taken to jail from the 11000 block of Browder Traylor Road by Deputy S. Squier for five traffic warrants out of Montgomery County JP 1. The male was stopped on a traffic violation.

On November 11, Deputy K. Berger was sent to a family violence assault call at a residence on Rocky Road. The Deputy met with a male complainant who advised he and his common law wife had gotten into an argument and she had hit him and scratched him numerous times. The Deputy observed numerous injuries to the male. The 19 year old female from Conroe was arrested at 9:42am and transported to jail.

On November 12, Deputy Z. Winford was dispatched to a disturbance call at a residence on Tanning Lane. The Deputy checked all subjects involved and found that two had outstanding warrants. A 48 year old male from Willis was arrested at 9:19pm for a theft by check warrant out of Montgomery County and a 33 year old female from Willis was arrested for a theft by check warrant out of Montgomery County and a theft by check warrant out of Harris County. Both were taken to jail.

District 2 – Lt. Brady Fitzgerald (South County)

On 11-07-12 at approximately 1133, Deputy Meredith received a criminal trespass at an address on Westwood Square. Upon arrival, he met with the involved parties. It was determined that a male from Montgomery had attempted to enter a residence. The male was arrested for Criminal Trespass and transported to MCSO Jail.

On 11-07-12 at approximately 1600, Deputy Underwood responded to an assault on Overlake Dr. Upon his arrival, he met with the involved parties, all family members. It was determined

that a physical assault took place. A female from Spring was arrested for Assault Family Violence and taken to jail.

On 11-03-12 at approximately 0820, Deputy Meredith was dispatched to an address on F.M. 1488 in reference to a disturbance. Upon the deputy's arrival, it was learned that a male from Spring was intoxicated and that he tried to get a convenience store clerk to watch his child so he could go get the car he wrecked. After the suspect's arrest a small amount of a controlled substance was found. The male was arrested for Driving while Intoxicated (with Child), and possession of a Dangerous Drug.

On 11-07-12 at approximately 2141, Deputy Wilkerson was dispatched to an address on Wedgewood in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival it was learned that a male from Magnolia had assaulted two people. The male was arrested for Assault and transported to MCSO Jail.

On 11-09-12 at approximately 0240, Deputy McKee was on patrol in the 400 block of Sawdust Road and he saw a vehicle parked in front of a business and a male was standing outside the car. The suspect was found to be intoxicated and was arrested.

On 11-09-12 at approximately 2230, Sgt. Barber responded to an assault at an address on Richards Rd. Upon his arrival, he met with the involved parties. The deputy determined that an assault took place and a female from Spring was arrested for Assault Family Violence.

On 11-11-12 at approximately 0245, Deputy Knight found a male from Neches sleeping inside a vehicle. Upon speaking with the male the deputy determined that he was intoxicated. The deputy also found that the suspect had outstanding warrants. The male was arrested for Public Intoxication and warrants.

District 3 – Lt. Joe Senn (East County)

10/30/12 Dep. Azwell responded to a welfare check and found a 46 year old female on location to have two Theft warrants. She was arrested without incident.

11/04/12 Dep. Azwell went to a family disturbance where he located a 29 year old female who had two Robbery warrants out of California. She was arrested and transported to CJC without incident.

11/07/12 Dep. Burk responded to a local bar in reference to a disturbance. All parties involved were gone when he arrived but he found one of the suspects riding a bicycle nearby. Upon investigation, he found that the 26 year old male was intoxicated to the point that he was a danger to himself. He was arrested for Public Intoxication.

11/07/12 Dep. Smith went to a family violence in progress. His investigation led to the arrest of a 46 year old male after it was found he injured his wife.

11/08/12 Dep. Azwell responded to a suspicious person. Investigation showed that the 41 year old male was waiting on friends to pick him up. He got bored so he entered a nearby garage and took 2 fishing poles. After he was arrested for Burglary of Building, he was found to be in Possession of a Dangerous Drug and was also charged for this offense.

11/08/12 Dep. Layman responded to a local fast food restaurant for a disturbance. Upon his arrival, he located a 43 year old male who was intoxicated. He was arrested for Public Intoxication.

11/08/12 Sr. Sgt. Rogers investigated a suspicious person at a local apartment complex. The 38 year old male was found to be intoxicated. He was arrested for Public Intoxication.

11/09/12 Dep. Bautista and Dep. Walker responded to a local grocery store regarding a theft in progress. The actor, a 44 year old male, was located after he fled. Investigation showed that he had stolen copper from a construction site and had also stolen items, including a motorized cart, from a nearby retail outlet. He was arrested and charged with 2 counts of Theft.

11/10/12 Dep. Bautista and Dep. Walker went to a theft in progress where the complainant had witnessed a 43 year old male was seen stealing a culvert. The male was arrested for Theft.

11/10/12 Dep. Slatter and Dep. White responded to a disturbance. Investigation found that a 33 year old male had assaulted and threatened family members. He was arrested for Assault, Terroristic Threat and 2 Traffic Warrants.

11/10/12 Dep. Stone investigated a suspicious person at a local church. It was found that the 33 year old male had stolen copper from the church property and caused damage to the A/C units. The male attempted to flee from Dep. Stone on a bicycle. The suspect became entangled in brush where he was arrested and charged with Evading Arrest, Felony Theft and Felony Criminal Mischief. A second suspect has not been arrested.

11/11/12 Dep. Jordan responded to a family disturbance. While on scene, he found that a 46 year old male had caused injury to two family members. He was arrested and charged with Assault.

11/11/12 Dep. Jordan was dispatched to a disturbance. During his investigation, it was discovered that a 21 year old male had caused injury to his wife. He was charged with Assault Family Violence and transported to jail.

11/14/12 Dep. Logan investigated a family disturbance where he found that a 17 year old assaulted a family member. She was arrested for Assault.

11/14/12 Dep. Slatter and Dep. White responded to the local medical clinic in response to a disturbance. Once there, they found that a 49 year old female was making threats towards others. She was arrested for Disorderly Conduct and transported to jail.

11/14/12 Dep. Logan responded to a suspicious person. He located a 40 year old female and a 20 year old male in the act of stealing copper tubing from an unoccupied residence. Both were arrested for Theft and the male was also charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance.

11/14/12 Dep. O'Connor was dispatched to a disturbance. While en route to the location, one of the parties fled. Dep. O'Connor located the vehicle and found that the driver, a 41 year old male, did not have an invalid driver's license. He was arrested for Driving While License Invalid.

District 4 – Lt. David Park (West County)

On November 13th Deputy Crandell was dispatched to Alford Road in reference to a Criminal Trespass. Dispatch advised a 32 year old male was on location trespassing. Upon arrival the subject was lying on a bench in the gated backyard of the residence. The homeowner arrived on location and advised he wanted to press charges. The subject was taken into custody.

On November 13th Deputy Irvine observed a vehicle traveling south on FM 1774 in the area of Misty Meadow. The Deputy attempted to conduct a traffic stop, but the driver continued driving and finally pulled into a residential driveway in Hunters Retreat. The driver provided a name and birth date of his brother but finally told the deputy his real name. The deputy found that the suspect was wanted for two Felony Warrants and one Misdemeanor Warrant. The Deputy placed the 21 year old into custody for the warrants and Failure to Identify/Fugitive from Justice.

On November 10th Deputy Brummett was dispatched to Single Tree Lane in reference to a Disturbance. Upon arrival the Deputy met with a 57 year old male who told the deputy that there was a warrant for his arrest. The deputy found that the suspect was wanted for DWI and placed him into jail.

On November 8th Deputy Thomas conducted a traffic stop and spoke with the 22 year old male driver. The deputy could smell an odor of Marijuana from the vehicle. The deputy found a small plastic bag of Marijuana in the suspect's shoe. Deputy Thomas placed the suspect into custody for Possession of Marijuana.

On November 6th Deputy Allen was dispatched to South Hall Drive in reference to a Welfare Check. Upon arrival the Deputy met with the Complainant who advised her 19 and 20 year old sons had been drinking and damaged her home, but they had run from house when they saw the deputy. Both suspects came out of the woods nearby but on the property of another and were arrested for Public Intoxication.

On November 6th Deputy Pullen was dispatched to Helene Ct in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival the Deputy met with the Complainant who advised his wife had come home intoxicated and slammed the lid of a lap top on his fingers. Deputy Pullen placed the 40 year old female in custody for Assault.

District 5 – Lt. Gary Welch (Northwest County)

November 7th Deputy Treille was dispatched to a residence on Tejas Blvd. in regards to Burglary of a Vehicle. The complainant reported that someone had entered their unlocked vehicle overnight and stole a laptop computer. This case is under investigation by the Patrol Division.

November 8th Deputy Davis responded to an establishment in the 17200 block of SH 105 W. in regards to a Disturbance. Deputies found that two male employees had been involved in a verbal altercation that turned physical and both were assaulted by the other. Both suspects were issued citations for Assault by Contact.

November 9th Deputy Pugh conducted a Traffic Stop in the 13200 block of SH 105W. Upon making contact with the male driver the deputy detected the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Further investigation resulted in marijuana and other narcotic paraphernalia being found in the vehicle. The male was arrested for Possession of Marijuana and placed in jail.

November 11th Sgt. Guion was dispatched to Lake Terrace Drive in regards to a Theft. The complainant reported that someone entered the fenced yard and stole the filtration system and pump to the pool. This case is currently under investigation by the Criminal Investigation Division.

November 12th Deputy Howze responded to a residence on Eastchase Lane in regards to an Assault. Deputies learned that a husband and wife had been involved in a physical altercation and the female was assaulted. The male was arrested for Assault and placed in jail.

District 6 – Lt. David Dottei (Woodlands)

On Wednesday November 7 Deputy Ortiz observed a suspicious vehicle driving through the parking lot. Deputy Ortiz conducted a traffic stop and made contact with the driver, a 40 year old female from The Woodlands, who had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage. The suspect was charged with Driving While Intoxicated and transported to the Montgomery County Jail.

On Thursday November 8, Deputy Conklin was patrolling the parking area at 2005 Lake Robbins when he observed parked vehicle with one occupant sitting inside. Deputy Conklin approached the vehicle and spoke with the occupant, a 19 year old male from Spring. The vehicle had a strong odor of marijuana emitting from the interior and the driver was found to have more in his possession. Charges were accepted for Possession of Marijuana and the suspect was transported to the Montgomery County Jail without incident.

On Thursday November 8, Deputy Johnson responded to a Shoplifter at 3040 College Park Drive. The suspect, a 22 year old female from Conroe, attempted to take \$162 worth of merchandise from Wal-Mart. The suspect was charged with Theft and transported to the Montgomery County Jail without incident.

On Saturday November 10, Deputy Prince responded to an Attempt to Locate in reference to a possible intoxicated driver. Witnesses advised dispatch of the suspect's location and Deputy Prince made contact with the driver at the intersection of North Woodstock Circle and Pineplank Drive. The driver, a 55 year old male from The Woodlands, was taken into custody for Driving While Intoxicated. The driver was taken the Montgomery County Jail without incident.

On Saturday November 10, Deputy Schutzenhofer was dispatched to 1201 Lake Woodlands in reference to two suspicious males on the roof. The suspects, both 17 year old males from Montgomery, had gained access to the roof by climbing over a locked security gate. Both were charged with Criminal Trespassing and were transported to the Montgomery County Jail without incident.

On Sunday November 11, Deputy Schutzenhofer was dispatched to a Suspicious Vehicle on Meadowmist Ct. Upon arrival to the scene, Deputy Schutzenhofer observed a vehicle parked in the roadway occupied by two males. As he approached the vehicle, Deputy Schutzenhofer noticed a strong odor of burnt marijuana. The driver of the vehicle, an 18 year old male, was charged with Possession of Marijuana after marijuana was found in the vehicle.

On Sunday November 11, Deputy Fruchtnict and Deputy McCoy responded to a Shoplifter at 3040 College Park Drive. The suspects, a 20 year old female and a 25 year old female both from Conroe, attempted to take \$62.44 worth of merchandise from Wal-Mart. Due to multiple theft convictions, the suspects were charged with Felony Theft and transported to the Montgomery County Jail without incident.
