**The Woodlands Township holds Board meeting**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (September 18, 2014) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors held a regular Board of Directors meeting on Thursday, September 18, 2014, at The Woodlands Township Town Hall, 2801 Technology Forest Boulevard, at 9 a.m. The entire meeting can be watched on video at The Woodlands Township website ([www.thewoodlandstowship-tx.gov](http://www.thewoodlandstowship-tx.gov)) The following actions were taken.

On the consent agenda, the Board approved:

- Administrative Reports for Law Enforcement and Community Policing for September 2014;
- Administrative Reports for Community Services for September 2014;
- Administrative Reports for The Woodlands Fire Department for September 2014;
- Administrative Reports for Transportation;
- A proclamation in support of National Night Out;
- A proclamation in support of International Walk to School Month;
- A Third Amendment to the Facilities Use Agreement between Lone Star College System and The Woodlands Township;

On the regular agenda, the Board:

- Adopted a resolution for changes in the Township's tax abatement policy;
- Received an update regarding traffic impacts to The Woodlands Township as a result of the San Jacinto River Authority construction plans for the Groundwater Reduction Plan;
- Received an update on The Woodlands Township Transit Plan and South Montgomery County Mobility Study;
- Tabled consideration for renewal of property and liability insurance for the policy period October 1, 2014 - October 1, 2015;



- Tabled consideration for revisions to Guidelines for Operating, Capital Replacement and Economic Development Reserves;
- Tabled consideration of a recommendation by the Ad Hoc Transportation Committee concerning RFPs and RFQs for transit-related services until final documents are drafted;
- The Board then recessed to Executive Session and no action was taken.
