**Drip Irrigation and Rainwater Harvesting Workshop on April 6, 2019**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (March 8, 2019) – The Woodlands Township Environmental Services Department presents a hands-on workshop to learn about the benefits of drip irrigation and how to install drip as part of a sprinkler system on Saturday, April 6, 2019, 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. at The Woodlands Emergency Training Center located at 16135 IH-45 South, Conroe, 77385.

Local drip irrigation and rainwater harvesting specialists will provide classroom and hands-on instruction for preparing lawns and landscaped areas for more efficient spring and summer irrigation. Instruction will focus on how to convert an existing spray head and create drip irrigation for an outdoor hose bibb. Additionally, participants will learn about installing a rain barrel as a source of water for gardens and beds.
