THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (June 29, 2020) – The Woodlands Township Wendtwoods Pool has followed an extensive cleaning and disinfecting procedure after two employees tested positive for COVID-19. The pool has been closed and is scheduled to reopen today, June 29, 2020.

The employees worked the below shifts at Wendtwoods Pool:

- June 14, 10:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- June 15, 10:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- June 16, 10:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- June 17, 10 a.m. to noon
- June 19, 11 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- June 20, 10:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- June 21, 5 to 6:30 p.m.
- June 23, 1 to 8:15 p.m.
- June 24, 10 a.m. to noon

Township staff members undergo daily temperature screenings upon reporting to work along with being asked a variety of questions regarding possible coronavirus exposure. The employee who tested positive was screened each day and did not present with an elevated temperature.
