New COVID-19 Testing Site in Montgomery County *Status Update from the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management*

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – The Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management is excited to announce an additional COVID-19 testing site in Montgomery County. This testing site will be at the Sterling Ridge Park and Ride on August 11th -14th from 8AM – 4PM. A valid form of identification is needed to be tested, and registration will be done on site.
