THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (September 24, 2021) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors held its regular meeting on Wednesday, September 22, 2021, at The Woodlands Township Townhall and discussed Incorporation election information and other topics.

The Board of Directors had the following on the Regular Agenda:
