



About The Woodlands Township's Law Enforcement Services



The Woodlands Township is a special purpose district providing municipal types of services to The Woodlands community. By law, The Woodlands Township cannot directly employ law enforcement officers; however, the Township contracts for supplemental law enforcement services in Montgomery County through a contract with Sheriff Rand Henderson and the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and in Harris County through a contract with Constable Mark Herman and the Harris County Constable's Office, Precinct 4. The Sheriff and Constable provide community policing services in eight residential villages and the tourism-commercial district located in Town Center. All villages have full-time deputies providing 24/7 coverage. The Township also contracts with Constable Ryan Gable and the Montgomery County Constable's Office, Precinct 3, for additional investigators specifically assigned to investigate crimes against children.

In addition to the Township's county-contracted community-policing law enforcement services, the counties also provide services in the crime scene and detective operations, administrative support, special services, SWAT team, training, recruitment, traffic control, identification – crime lab, communications, sex offender division, fleet maintenance and operations, jail division, auto theft task force, organized crime, and narcotics units, as well as other areas through the county tax levy. The Woodlands Township contracts with the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office for policing in the eight policing response areas, comprising seven residential villages and one commercial district. Together, these zones make up the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office South Patrol, The Woodlands Township Division. The Village of Creekside Park is policed by the Harris County Constable's Office,

Nine policing response zones:

- Grogan's Mill
- Panther Creek
- Indian Springs
- Sterling Ridge
- Alden Bridge
- Cochran's Crossing
- College Park
- Town Center (tourism and commercial zone)
- Creekside Park

Please keep in mind that this report offers a snapshot in time for each of the months included based on the timing of when the data was provided by law enforcement. Due to the fluid nature of the criminal investigation, some of the data may have developed further after the report data was released.
