The Woodlands Township seeking input for transit plan

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (March 27, 2023) – The Woodlands Township has created a transit plan for commuters, residents and visitors to share thoughts on traveling both within areas of The Woodlands and commuting to the Houston area.

The Woodlands Township Transit Plan will provide a framework to increase ridership, reduce travel times and right-size service as the region emerges from the COVID-19 pandemic. This study will evaluate ways to improve post-COVID transit service across fixed route/ADA paratransit and commuter bus, improve driver retention and evaluate the potential of expanding service across different geographies and users.

This process will provide a targeted and comprehensive response to inform improvement priorities, as well as provide a framework for funding and implementation specific for The Woodlands Township and surrounding area.
