**Township encourages residents to be informed regarding construction and utility projects**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (June 13, 2013) – Several roadway and utility projects are currently underway to prepare for future growth of The Woodlands. While The Woodlands Township organization is not directly managing or funding these projects, The Woodlands Township is striving to keep residents and businesses updated of these highly visible projects.

One of the major projects underway is the Groundwater Reduction Plan by the San Jacinto River Authority. This project includes the construction of water pipelines through The Woodlands which will bring in surface water from Lake Conroe. Planning for this project has been going on for many years with construction scheduled to be complete by 2015. Pre-construction activities are already beginning in far western and northern sections of The Woodlands, with the majority of the construction planned for 2014 in The Woodlands.
