The Woodlands Township holds Board meeting

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (March 21, 2014) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors held a regular Board of Directors meeting on Thursday, March 20, 2014, at The Woodlands Township Town Hall, 2801 Technology Forest Boulevard, at 9 a.m. The entire meeting can be watched on video at The Woodlands Township website (www.thewoodlandstowship-tx.gov) The following actions were taken.

On the Consent Agenda, the Board took actions that included:

- Approved a Special Event Permit for the South County 4th of July Parade;
- Approved a Special Event Permit for the Pink 5K Walk Against Breast Cancer;
- Approved an annual survey of prevailing wage rates and scale for construction projects and adopt a resolution in connection therewith;
- Approved an aerial easement with CenterPoint Energy in the Village of Sterling Ridge Section 29, ROSR E;
- Awarded a bid for concession stand operations at Rob Fleming Aquatic Center and for selected programs;
- Approved an application hosting and technology support services agreement with Xerox Government Systems, LLC. for Firehouse Cloud;

On the regular agenda, the Board took actions that included:

- Acknowledged the achievement of the distinguished ISO 1 rating awarded to The Woodlands Fire Department. (Please see separate release.)
- Discussed, amended and approved a Proclamation in support of Earth Day;
- Received an update on The Woodlands Township Transit Plan and South Montgomery County Mobility Study;
- Received an update on law enforcement;
- Approved changes to the Board Policy on Meeting Format as it relates to Administrative Reports;
- Received a presentation from Waste Management concerning funding for environmental education;
- Received and tabled for later discussion a presentation from Retirement Horizons, Inc.;
- Approved the funding of the repaving of Bear Branch Sportsfields;



- Approved moving forward with design and development Gosling Sports Park concept plan and engineering services;
- Approved a transportation fund budget amendment;
- Tabled the discussion of the Service Agreement between The Township and the Convention and Visitors Bureau.
