The Woodlands Township holds Board meeting

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (July 18, 2014) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors held a regular Board of Directors meeting on Thursday, July 17, 2014, at The Woodlands Township Town Hall, 2801 Technology Forest Boulevard, at 9 a.m. The entire meeting can be watched on video at The Woodlands Township website (www.thewoodlandstowship-tx.gov).

On the consent agenda, the Board approved the following:

- Minutes of the June 2, 2014 Special Board Meeting, June 19, 2014 Regular Board Meeting, and June 25, 2014 Regular Board Meeting for the Board of Directors of The Woodlands Township;
- Administrative Reports for The Woodlands Fire Department for July 2014;
- Administrative Reports for Community Services for July 2014;
- Execution of a Joint Election Agreement with Montgomery County, Texas and possibly other jurisdictions in Montgomery County, Texas;
- Execution of an Election Services Agreement with Montgomery County, Texas;
- Execution of an Election Services Agreement with Harris County, Texas;
- Special Event Permit for the YMCA Kiwanis Kids Triathlon;
- Conveyance of Village of Creekside Park Section 26, ROSR A;
- Water Line Easement with San Jacinto River Authority;

On the regular agenda, the Board:

- Received an update regarding traffic impacts to The Woodlands Township as a result of the San Jacinto River Authority construction plans for the Groundwater Reduction Plan;
- Deferred an update on The Woodlands Township Transit Plan and South Montgomery County Mobility Study to the next meeting;
- Received presentations by outside organizations requesting 2015 budget funding:
 1. The Woodlands Area Economic Development Partnership
 2. South County YMCA
 3. Interfaith of The Woodlands
 4. Montgomery County Precinct 3 Justice of the Peace (not present)
 5. Montgomery County Precinct 3 Constable's Office;



- Received a 2014 Memorial Hermann Ironman Texas Summary presentation;
- Deferred a quarterly update from The Woodlands Convention and Visitors Bureau to the next meeting;
- Approved the Fire Chiefs Association agreement renewal and briefing on existing Secondary Public Safety Answering Point;
- Approved a resolution regarding the expansion and remodeling of the facilities for the Montgomery Central Appraisal District;
- Deferred a recommendation by the Ad Hoc Transportation Committee to support Conroe/The Friendship Center/The Woodlands grant application for new buses and sharing of the local match as recommended by the Ad Hoc Transportation Committee to the next meeting;
- The Board then recessed to closed session and afterward took no action.

The Board then considered items to be placed on the next meeting's agenda. The next meeting will be held Wednesday, July 23, 2014, at 6 p.m..
