Media Advisory: Jones State Forest conducting prescribed burn

CONROE, Texas – Texas A&M Forest Service will be conducting a 3-acre prescribed burn on W. Goodrich Jones State Forest, Wednesday, November 19 starting around 10 a.m. and concluding at approximately 3:00 p.m.

The purpose of tomorrow's prescribed burn is to facilitate TFS and local fire departments in their level of training preparedness and radio communications.

The affected area is located north of FM 1488 and between SH 242 and Peoples Road. (Please see attached maps of state forest and of proposed prescribed burn area in yellow - **30°14'13"N and - 95°29'3"W**)

Texas A&M Forest Service is notifying surrounding city and fire officials, as well as area residents and groups who frequent the forest, by email and posting signs in adjoining rights of way. Agency firefighters and equipment will be stationed at the forest as a precautionary measure.
