The Woodlands Township holds Board meeting, elects officers for 2015

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (November 20, 2014) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors held a regular Board of Directors meeting on Wednesday, November 19, 2014, at The Woodlands Township Town Hall, 2801 Technology Forest Boulevard, at 6 p.m. The entire meeting can be watched on video at The Woodlands Township website (www.thewoodlandstowship-tx.gov). The following actions were taken.

- Approved the forms of the Oaths of Office, Official Bonds and Statements of Elected/Appointed Officers for the newly elected Directors of The Woodlands Township;
- Administrated the Oath of Office to newly elected Directors of The Woodlands Township, those being Gordy Bunch, Mike Bass, Jeff Long and Ed Robb;
- Elected Officers for the Board of Directors for The Woodlands Township to be as follows: Chairman Bruce Tough, Vice Chairman Ed Robb, Secretary Mike Bass and Treasurer Gordy Bunch.
- Appointed newly elected Directors to The Woodlands Township Economic Development Zone Board of Directors;
