Residential Design Review Committee volunteers needed for Creekside Park, Sterling Ridge, Indian Springs and Panther Creek

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (March 6, 2015) – Volunteers are needed to fill vacant positions on The Woodlands Residential Design Review Committees (RDRC) for the Villages of Creekside Park, Sterling Ridge, Indian Springs (East of Falconwing) and Panther Creek. Volunteers must reside in their respective village in order to serve on the committee.

Resident property owners who are able to meet on the first Thursday of each month for Sterling Ridge and Creekside Park, and on the second Thursday of each month for Panther Creek and Indian Springs (East of Falconwing), may call or stop by The Woodlands Township, 2801 Technology Forest Boulevard, to obtain an application. Applications are also available online at www.thewoodlandstowship-tx.gov, under Residential Design Review Committees. Filing for the positions ends on March 23, 2015, at 5 p.m.

The Residential Design Review Committees are the architectural control groups within the community. Committee members serve in a volunteer capacity and represent the resident viewpoint essential to the evaluation and approval process that protects the integrity of neighborhoods and the natural beauty of The Woodlands. Each village committee meets once a month to review property owners' applications for modifications or improvements to their properties.
