**Watch Talk Wednesday focuses on how to notice and report suspicious activity**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (April 20, 2015) – The Montgomery County Sheriff’s Office District 6 Crime Prevention Unit Deputy Jason Hopper and Corporal Danny Dickson will discuss *What’s Suspicious?* at the next *Watch Talk Wednesday* from noon to 1 p.m. Wednesday, April 22, 2015, at The Woodlands Township Town Hall, 2801 Technology Forest Boulevard, The Woodlands 77381. The meeting will be held in Public Meeting Rooms 150/152. Residents should enter at the left/west side of the building.

The presentation’s emphasis will be about the role residents play in keeping our community safe. Attendees will learn about: heightened awareness of behaviors that might appear suspicious, what information is important and how to effectively report suspicious activity. Also, The Woodlands Township Neighborhood Watch will be introducing information on their newest crime prevention initiative, Dog Walker Watch and “Yappy Hours,” and how you can get involved. The meeting will provide useful crime prevention tips for everyone.
