## **Arts in the Park presents Shakespeare in the Park**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (September 6, 2016) – Arts in the Park features a live performance of Shakespeare's *A Midsummer Night's Dream* with musical accompaniment by The Woodlands Symphony Orchestra at Rob Fleming Park on September 17, 2016 at dusk. Township residents are encouraged to enjoy a full day and evening of activities with family and friends at this free event in Rob Fleming Park, located at 6055 Creekside Forest Drive, The Woodlands, 77389, from 2 to 9 p.m. Arts in the Park will feature food trucks, a kids' zone, local vendors selling original artwork, fun activities for children and entertaining stage performances.

Art vendor booths are available for a \$50 fee, which includes one 10' X 10' tent, a table and two chairs. Art vendors may bring additional stands or items needed to display their wares. Art vendors must be able to set up in grass. The vendor fee for a food truck is \$75 and includes dedicated parking for the food truck and an additional vehicle, ability to sell food during event, and public service announcement recognition during the event. Art vendor sales end at 6 p.m. the day of the event. The kids' zone, featuring crafts and inflatables, will be available until 6 p.m. Concessions will be available for purchase until 9 p.m.
