The last rental out is 6:30 p.m. No reservations are accepted on holidays, as rentals are available on a walk-up basis. During the first hour at both boathouses, single kayaks rent for \$15 and tandem kayaks for \$20. Each additional hour is \$5. Stand-up paddle boards are available to rent for \$20 the first hour and \$5 each additional hour. Lifejackets and paddles are included with each rental.
