## **SAT Testing - May 6- Avoid travel delays during CB&I TRI-The Woodlands Triathlon**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (May 5, 2017) – The 14th annual CB&I TRI–The Woodlands Triathlon is set for Saturday, May 6, 2017, beginning at 7 a.m. The bike course has the potential to impact resident that normally use the following roads to travel to the SAT Testing site at The Woodlands High School: Lake Woodlands Drive, Grogan’s Mill Road, Sterling Ridge Drive, Woodlands Parkway and Carlton Woods Drive.

After the race starts, roads will re-open on a rolling basis as soon as the last participant has passed and all course support materials have been removed. These particular areas will be congested throughout the event, and residents are encouraged to use extreme caution while traveling throughout the course. Proper planning and awareness of lane closure schedules should help alleviate any major interruptions. There will be a police officer at every intersection along the race route, and deputies will attempt to allow cars through, if and only when there is a safe opportunity.
