THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (June 28, 2017) – Residents and spectators are invited to celebrate Independence Day at the Township’s Annual Red Hot & Blue Festival, presented by CHI St. Luke’s Health – The Woodlands Hospital, and Fireworks Extravaganza.

Celebrate freedom in The Woodlands with live entertainment and activities at multiple parks in The Woodlands, Tuesday, July 4, 2017, from 6 to 10 p.m. Fireworks begin approximately at 9:30 p.m. with a simulcast on Woodlands Hits. Event goers and spectators are encouraged to download the [www.WoodlandsHits.com](http://www.WoodlandsHits.com) free application to experience both the sights and sounds of the Fireworks Extravaganza. It can also be found by searching “Woodlands Hits” in the App Store or on Google Play.

Residents should be advised the Cove and majority of the Northshore Park boat docks will not be available for use Friday, June 30, through Wednesday, July 5, 2017, due to event preparations. Vehicular access into the park will be restricted on Tuesday, July 4, 2017. On Sunday, July 2, 2017, Northshore Park will be closed from 6 to 9 a.m. to accommodate further set up.
