**Burglary of motor vehicle incidents addressed at Watch Talk Wednesday**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (July 20, 2017) – Residents are invited to find out how to help reduce the occurrence of Burglary of Motor Vehicle (BMV) incidents at the next Watch Talk Wednesday presentation, from 7 to 9 p.m. on August 9, 2017. Montgomery County Sheriff’s Office Crime Prevention Unit Deputy Kellie Christiansen and Deputy Stephanie Coroiescu will share data on where this crime occurs, discuss current BMV trends, dangers of leaving valuables in vehicles and details on what individuals can do to prevent BMVs.
