Waste Management Regular Service: Trash, Recycling, Green Waste, Bulky Pick-up

CURBSIDE SERVICE

- All curbside services will be available starting Monday, September 11, including trash, recycling, yard trimmings, and bulk pickup.
- [Please continue to follow all normal solid waste guidelines.](#)
- Waste Management does not have the capacity to pick up extra recycling set-outs. Items left outside the cart will not be picked up. If you are unable to store your extra recycling until the following week, please consider depositing your excess items at one of the area Drop-Off Centers - hours below.

RECYCLING CENTERS

- The Woodlands Recycling Center at 5310 Research Forest Drive will resume normal operating hours starting Wednesday, September 13: Wednesdays from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
*Tree branches up 12" in diameter are accepted here. No storm debris accepted.
- The Precinct 3 Recycle Center at 1122 Pruitt Rd has resumed normal operating hours as of Thursday, September 7: Monday through Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. For a complete list of accepted recyclables, please see www.precinct3.org/recycling or call 281-367-7283.

Storm Debris Removal Services

General Information:

Follow the guidelines for debris pickup. The debris needs to be separated and placed on the county right-of-way for the trucks to pick it up. The contractors will not go on private property.

Residents should separate items into **6 different piles** in the county right-of-way. **DO NOT PUT DEBRIS IN BAGS:**

- Normal household trash – place in your Waste Management green cart. Excess normal household trash must be bagged and tagged with pink tags available at The Woodlands Township offices and at Kroger and Randall's in The Woodlands for \$1.75 each. Each bag of excess trash may not exceed 40 pounds.
- Vegetative debris (tree limbs, trees, shrubs, plants)



- Construction/demolition debris (sheetrock, carpet, wood, flooring, furniture)
- White goods (refrigerators, ranges, water heaters, freezers, unit air conditioners, washing machines, clothes dryers, and other similar domestic and commercial large appliances)
- E-waste (electronics)
- Household hazardous waste (paint, oil, cleaning supplies, fuel)

Montgomery County Residents

If you have debris from the Hurricane, register on www.mctxoem.org to be put on the list for pickup.

The Precinct 3 Debris Drop-Off Site at 1122 Pruitt Rd is now open Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. They are accepting household storm debris and green debris from Precinct 3 residents only; must present Driver's License for verification
