Below is a list of items needed for the rehabilitation of orphaned, injured, or displaced native Texas wildlife. The care and feeding of animals is provided by volunteer rehabilitators.

Animal Foods

- Science Diet Feline Maintenance Light dry cat food (used for songbirds)
- Dry puppy or dog chow
- Pecans or peanuts (whole in shell or pieces, unsalted)
- Pedialyte (store brand ok) bottle or freezer pops
- Wild birdseed or black oil sunflower seed

Paper Items

- Paper towels
- Baby wipes (unscented)
- Tissues (no lotion added)
- Zip-loc bags, gallon and quart size
- Kitchen trash bags
- White printer paper or cardstock

Cleaning Supplies

- Liquid bleach and liquid laundry detergent (for HE machine)
- Liquid dish soap (Dawn is preferred)
- Liquid hand soap and hand sanitizer

Miscellaneous Items

- “Kritter Keepers” plastic aquariums, medium size
- Polar fleece blankets or fabric (cut into 2 foot squares)
- pet hammocks (for ferrets, guinea pigs, cats)
- Ceramic food bowls
- Squirrel or owl nesting boxes (can look online for directions to build)
- Gift cards to grocery stores (for fresh produce) or Lowes/Home Depot (build cages)
