



Pathway Rules

- Show courtesy and respect to other pathway users.
- Use right side of the pathway; pass on the left.
- Avoid putting yourself and others at risk.
- Listen for audible signals; allow other pathway users to pass.
- Keep dogs on a leash and clean up after them.
- Always yield to wheelchairs.
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited (*except for handicapped or maintenance*).
- Bike at a reasonable speed.

Prohibited

- Glass containers
- Vandalism
- Removal/destruction of vegetation
- Fires (except barbecue grills)
- Littering and dumping
- Disorderly conduct
- Excessive noise
- Swimming in lakes/ponds
- Vehicles left overnight
- Horseback riding
- Fireworks
- Soliciting funds or donations
- Guns/weapons
- Distributing circulars
- Selling goods and services

Note: *Biking, walking and jogging are at your own risk. Please use the pathways during daylight hours only and preferably with a companion. Be aware of traffic, animals, and other potential dangers.
