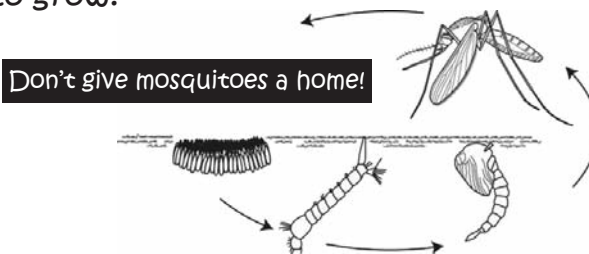


Dear Parents,

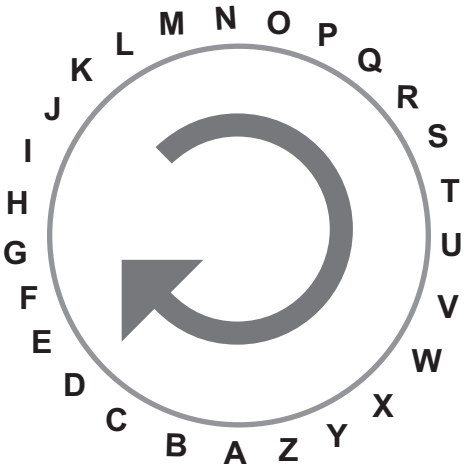
Asian tigers and many other mosquitoes lay their eggs in standing water.

- Throw bzmr , izqr and ansskdr and their khcr and bzor into the trash.
- When mosquitoes are active wear knmf , khfgs , knnrd clothes and ask an adult to help you put on qdodkkdms .
- Bgzmfd the water in ods anvkr and ahqcazsgr every day.
- Don't nudqvzsdq flowers beds and kzvnr .
- Ask a ozqdms to bkdzm out the qzhm ftssdqr on your home.
- Pick up snxr like atbjdsr and vzfnmr in your yard that can hold vzsdq .
