This memorandum summarizes Economic & Planning Systems' (EPS) explanation for a change in financial assumptions regarding the capital road projects cost estimate for The Woodlands Township Incorporation Study Working Paper #2.

Original Estimate

As part of the one-time capital projects estimated in The Woodlands Township Incorporation Study Working Paper #2, EPS estimated the one-time capital projects associated with potential major road improvements. This estimate was based on an inventory of necessary and desired projects compiled by the Montgomery County Precinct 3 Public Works department. The total of these projects, assuming the highest quality repairs, is approximately \$132.4 million.

New Estimate

Upon further review, many of the road projects included in this inventory are actually located outside of The Woodlands Township boundaries. Despite this fact, the majority of costs represented on the list are still located in the Township as follows and shown in **Figure 1**:

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The Economics of Land Use

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- Of the 26 concrete road projects identified on the Montgomery County inventory, 19 are located in the project, or approximately \$75.2 million.
- Of the 217 asphalt projects identified on the Montgomery County inventory, only 8 are located in the project, or approximately \$2.7 million.
- Of the 12 curb and gutter projects identified on the Montgomery County inventory, all 12 are located in the project, or approximately \$245,000.
- In total, the Township estimates 39 projects located in Montgomery County Precinct 3 would become the responsibility of The Woodlands upon incorporation, or \$78.2 million. This is approximately 60.0 percent of the original \$132.4 million estimate.

The \$78.2 million only represent the potential necessary projects in Precinct 3. While this precinct is by far the largest precinct (329 road miles), there are 106 miles of roads in Precincts 2 (93 miles) and 4 (13 miles) that would also fall under the responsibility of The Woodlands under incorporation. Upon discussion with the Montgomery County engineer, the County does not estimate or identify any necessary immediate capital projects for the portion of these Precinct roads located in the Woodlands. Thus, EPS does not estimate any additional costs above the \$80.1 million identified in Precinct 3.

Impact to Analysis

Combined with other estimated one-time capital costs, new one-time capital costs are estimated to total \$91.5 versus \$145.7 million under the previous assumption, or a net reduction of \$54.2 million. Assuming the same debt assumptions as previously established, one-time capital costs are estimated to result in an Other Funds property tax rate of \$0.0464 versus \$0.0739 under the previous assumption, or \$0.0275 lower than previously estimated. As a result of the above, EPS estimates the new property tax rate upon incorporation to total \$0.5539 versus \$0.5814, or a net reduction of \$0.0275.
