1. Will you have the VIP areas nailed down by next week when questions are due?
 - a. No.
2. Is this the first drone show for The Township?
 - a. Yes.
3. Can you share the interested vendor list?
 - a. The list will be posted to the website. [See link.](#)
4. Are 250 or 300-399 the minimum quantity of drones required?
 - a. The minimum show size is 200 drones. The Township requests fees for various size shows as outlined in Exhibit A.
5. When will the contract be awarded?
 - a. The Board of Directors will review the proposals submitted at their March Board meeting. If the Board accepts a proposal(s), contracting will take place in April.
6. Can the future Ritz Carlton location be used for a take-off/landing site?
 - a. This area is currently grass and brush. Howard Hughes has tentatively agreed to allow the vendor to use the site, however, additional insurance will be required as follows:

- Selected vendor must submit a Certificate of Insurance with the insurance limits and coverages shown in the table above in full force and effect; and must name The Woodlands Township and The Woodlands Land Development Company, L.P. as Additional Insureds; and, must contain a Waiver of Subrogation; contain a provision for

ten (10) days prior written notice to the Township if the policy expires or is canceled or changed; not have exclusions in the insurance coverage regarding publicly owned or leased property or Township operations or personnel, employees, licensees or agents.

7. Will there be any boats on the water?
 - a. Yes. The Woodlands Fire Department and Montgomery County Sheriff's Office, at The Township's cost, provide patrols for this area during large fireworks shows to establish safety zones.
8. Will there be multiple VIP locations?
 - a. One VIP location will be provided for the drone/fireworks show.
9. Will there be traffic control on Lake Woodlands?
 - a. Yes. This is provided by Montgomery County Sheriff's Office, at The Township's cost. Typically, for fireworks shows, this road is closed 1 hour prior to the show and 1 hour after the show.
