Note: This Addendum shall be included as part of the Bid Form Documents. Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Bid Form and on the Bid Tabulation. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to Disqualification.

Clarification:

1. The Bid Tabulation Form states 150 cubic yards of latex paint under the “Estimated 2026 Quantities” column. This is an error and should say **75 cubic yards**. Please provide bid tabulation for latex paint based on a quantity of 75 cubic yards.

Questions:

1. Does contract fall under their existing contract with H-GAC for prices and terms?
No, this will not. The event is funded in part through an H-GAC grant, but the pricing and terms for this event will fall under our own independent contract.

2. The invitation for bid indicates that the estimate is for an 800-car event. Has The Woodlands had an HHW event in the past? Did 800 cars come through the line?

The Woodlands has not held an HHW event in the past. However, we have held yearly recycling drive-thru events for various recyclables and processed about 600 people on average in a three-hour window.

3. The bid has the latex paint at 125 cubic yard boxes which is a very large amount. A typical 800 car event might have 50 cubic yard boxes of latex paint.

Please see clarification above on the correct quantity, which is 75 cubic yards. This can be prepared in 75 cubic yard boxes or alternatively represents three 25-yard roll-off containers full of paint. All payment will be based on actual amounts collected.

4. Will The Woodlands provide 30-yard roll-off boxes for solid waste and or cardboard recycling? The solid waste would be the empty gas cans, empty oil containers, plastic tubs and bins that the participants bring materials in for disposal. These events generate a ton of cardboard because some of the participants bring their materials in boxes, and they don't want it back.

Yes, The Woodlands Township will provide two 30-yard roll-off containers for trash and recycling. However, the Contractor is responsible for safe disposal of any materials which could still be considered flammable or

otherwise hazardous. If additional roll-off containers provided by the Contractor or their Subcontractor are needed for any waste streams listed on the bid tabulation form, please include that in your supply costs.

5. Does the parking lot have any restrooms?

Yes, the Sterling Ridge Park & Ride has indoor restrooms that will be open and available to the Contractor.

6. Can the site be set up the Friday afternoon before the event? Can it be secured that night?

Since this facility is used for weekday commuting, setup cannot begin on Friday. The Contractor may begin set up as early as 6:30 a.m. on the morning of the event.
